





Summer Term — Budding Curiosity

Maths:

In Mathematics, we will be covering the following skills:



- Place value to 50 and beyond (100)
- Addition and subtraction
- Measurement
- Multiplication and division (reinforce multiples of 2, 5 and 10).
- Fractions



English:

In the summer term, we will be using the following texts to develop our narrative, instructional and diary writing - focusing on the Year 1 objectives:

- Jack and the Beanstalk
- Jasper's Beanstalk
- Oliver's Vegetables
- Handa's Surprise
- E book—Plants



Science:

In Science, we will be covering a range of skills to develop our knowledge and understanding of plants; such as:

- Identify and name a variety of common, wild and garden plants including trees
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants including trees
- Gather and record data
- Record simple tests
- Plant seed and watch them grow in different environments



PE



We will have PE lessons on Thursday and Friday PM for class IB and IT. PE kits are to go home weekly and be washed and returned Monday mornings please so they are in school ready for their next lesson.

Budding Curiosity—Geography

Our theme for this term is 'Budding Curiosity! Throughout the term, we will be developing our geography skills and focusing on the following:

- Contrasting areas of the UK compared to a non EU country
- Use basic geographic vocabulary
- Use simple field work
- Use aerial photos and understand a key

In PSHE, we will be exploring living in the wider world and how to look after the local environment.

RE

In RE, we are going to be exploring symbols, beliefs and stories related to Sikhism.

In Art we are developing a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space. We will be looking at Vincent Van Gough's art to create our own versions.
