Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: YEAR 4 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO WHITEMOOR LAKES

As you will be aware, within our programme of extra-curricular activities, each year we plan a residential visit to an education outdoor centre called Whitemoor Lakes. The centre provides a wide variety of outdoor learning experiences, particularly adventurous educational ones such as team building, problem solving as well as climbing, zip wire and abseiling activities. This year's visit has been booked for Wednesday 16th to Friday 18th March inclusive and will cost approximately £136.05 per child / £108.80 if your child is entitled to free school meals. The final cost will be determined once we have exact numbers wishing to participate. This will enable us to split the cost of travel fairly. Should the price need to be reduced or increased, we anticipate this being a difference of a minimum of £5.00.

To make the finances more manageable, we ask for an initial deposit of £30 (payable by Wednesday 20th October) and the remaining balance to be paid by instalment as outlined below, via ParentPay.

A place will not be reserved if the deposit is not received by the due date as Whitemoor Lakes will only reserve for the number of children we pay for. Your child's place may be withdrawn by Whitemoor Lakes if we are not able to send payments at regular set date intervals. Therefore, it is vital that all payments are made by the dates listed above.

Consent is given and payments are to be made via ParentPay.

To provide further information about our intended visit, we would like to invite you to an information sharing meeting on Thursday 14th October 5:30 pm. Mr Clarkson will lead the meeting as he has undertaken many visits to the Centre. The meeting will take place in the School Hall. We look forward to welcoming as many of you as possible.
