

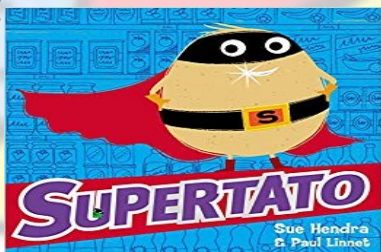
## Theme

- Know that animals produce young and that these grow into adults.
- Explain the basic stages in a life cycle for animals including humans.
- Compare needs of babies and toddlers.
