Each week, we will have a focus book which will be chosen due to the children's interest or linked to a particular topic or event.

Within the first couple of week, reading books will be given out for you to read and discuss with your child.

We will be starting the year by practising getting changed into P.E kits. Therefore we ask that you encourage your child to get dressed independently.

P.E lessons will consist of various games and activities that focus on spatial awareness, gross motor skills and balancing.
